MONDAY 29 JANUARY 2018

LET US PRAY FOR RESTORATION

SCRIPTURES

- Isaiah 61:7: For your shame ye shall have double; and for confusion they shall rejoice in their portion: therefore in their land they shall possess the double: everlasting joy shall be unto them.
- Joel 2:25-26: I pray that you will restore to me all the years that the swarming locust has eaten
- Psalm 103:5: I pray that you will renew my youth like the eagles.
- Job 42:10; Zechariah 9:12: Isaiah 61:7 - I trust that you will restore unto me double of what I've lost in quality and/or quantity!
- Jeremiah 30:17: You shall restore my health and heal me of my wounds.

Let us pray:

1. Let us pray for our loved ones, communities and the City of Tshwane into salvation and repentance
2. Let us pray for God's capacity to disciple individuals to be established into Christ Jesus
3. Let us pray for the revival into lives of individuals.

TUESDAY 30 JANUARY 2018

LET US PRAY FOR BALANCE IN OUR LIVES

SCRIPTURES

Joel 2:12-13: Turn to Me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning.' So rend your hearts, not your garments; Return to the Lord your God..."

Isaiah 66:9 : Shall I bring to the birth, and not cause to bring forth?" says the LORD: "shall I who cause to bring forth shut the womb?" says your God.

Let us pray:

1. Let us pray that God move us away from a location of wastage into the shadow of his wings in 2018.

2. You have carried your dream long enough, you have held onto the promises of God long enough. Declare that this is now your time to enter and break forth into enlargement.
3. Ask God to activate every person or entity he has ordained to connect you towards your enlargement and that his favour begins to work for you.
4. Let us pray for the spirit of innovation upon our lives to develop our human capacity. Let us refuse and rebuke grasshopper's mentality in our lives.

WEDNESDAY 31 JANUARY 2018

LET US PRAY FOR THE SPIRIT OF EXCELLENCE IN OUR LIVES

SCRIPTURES

Daniel 6:1-3: **1** It pleased Darius to set over the kingdom an hundred and twenty princes, which should be over the whole kingdom; **2** And over these three presidents; of whom Daniel was first: that the princes might give accounts unto them, and the king should have no damage. **3** Then this Daniel was preferred above the presidents and princes, because an excellent spirit was in him; and the king thought to set him over the whole realm.

Deuteronomy 1:8: See, I have placed the land before you; go in and possess the land which the LORD swore to give to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to them and their descendants after them.

Let us pray:

1. Let us for God to remove every hindrance on my way to greatness in Jesus' name.
2. Let the Holy Spirit help us to identify and deal with any weakness in us and around us that can hinder our progress.
3. Let us ask God to transform us through the leadership of the Holy Spirit, to be a church of prayer with an excellent spirit, to be an assembly that lives under the rule of the God of the heavens. Make us people of prayer for his sake. Make us those who turn the age for his sake. Let us ask God to uplift our prayers as the FGT and increase our prayer life!
4. Let us ask the Holy Spirit to help us to grow in holiness, righteousness and godly living so we can:
 - Be Christians who are fully committed to life of prayer and the teaching of the Word.
 - Be a church driven by love and compassion (in order to outlive themselves).
 - Be selfless givers – in our time, resources and money.
 - Be passionate for soul winning and evangelism around the City of Tshwane.
5. Let us ask God for the land of our own. That we stand firm in the knowledge that we shall have our Title Deed for the land where the church building will be situated.
 - Declare that FGT will experience joy and laughter in this season and beyond.
 - Pray for true spiritual growth and maturity in every member of FGT.
 - Declare that the set time FOR God to favour FGT is now.

BREAKING THE CURSES / VOWS FROM OUR LINEAGE

1. Generational Curses

Judges 6: ²⁵ That same night the LORD said to him, "Take the second bull from your father's herd, the one seven years old. ^[b] Tear down your father's altar to Baal and cut down the Asherah pole ^[c] beside it. ²⁶ Then build a proper kind of ^[d] altar to the LORD your God on the top of this height. Using the wood of the Asherah pole that you cut down, offer the second ^[e] bull as a burnt offering."

Prayer Points

Let us pray and cut off those **rituals** we were once open to, cut off those vows and the responsibilities that may have been attached to our names. Let us pray and break those generational curses.

Let us call those things by name and renounce them.

- **Ancestral worship:** we will serve no foreign Gods
- **Hereditary / bloodline curses:** no sicknesses or diseases from our forefathers or previous generation line will filter its way to us and our line.
- **Spirit of witchcraft:** any curse / ritual performed or spoken over our lives we render powerless. It won't work. We are cover with the Blood of Jesus.
- **Poverty:** poverty is a curse: poverty will not enter our family line. It will not hold us back from prospering an advancing academically and financially. The road for our children will be green pasture. Blessings will overtake them. Goodness and mercy will follow them all the days of their lives and they will live to see the Goodness of the Lord in the land of the living.

2. The power of the tongue / breaking every curse spoken over our lives.

- ISAIAH 50:4: "The Lord God has given me. The tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to *him who is weary*. He awakens me morning by morning, He awakens my ear to hear as the learned.
- ISAIAH 54:17: no weapon forged against you will prevail, and you will refute every tongue that accuses you. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and this is their vindication from me," declares the LORD.
- PSALM 141:3 *Set a guard, O Lord, over my mouth; keep watch over the door of my lips.*

Let us pray:

1. Let us pray and cut off every curse of the tongue and every negative word spoken over our lives.
2. Let us declare the truths which comfort the broken, the contrite heart, those weary of sin and harassed with afflictions.
3. Ask God to give you a passion for prayer, to arise early in the mornings to pray and to hear what the Spirit of God is saying. Let's speak life over every situation.

Let us pray and cut off the following:

1. Break the spirit of gossip over your life, over your family and over the church as well. Gossip will demotivate the church from advancing, it will hinder the vision and stagnate people from their true calling and from God's divine plan for the church.

2. Break every curse spoken over your life. No negative word will take route over your life. Refute every false tongue that speaks against you and your line.
3. Ask God to guard our hearts and keep watch over the door of our lips. Whatever we say must bring Glory to His name and encouragement to His people. Whatever we do must bring Honour to His name and unity amongst His people.
4. Pray for unity in families, at the work place and more especially for unity in the church. God commands blessings when people are united. Blessings start to attract each other when there is unity. We are a House of Healing and a Home for All, therefore everyone should be united in one spirit called Cohesion.

SCRIPTURES

Colossians 3:13-15: ¹³ Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others. ¹⁴ Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony. ¹⁵ And let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts. For as members of one body you are called to live in peace. And always be thankful.

1 Corinthians 1:10: I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another in what you say and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united in mind and thought.

Psalms 133:1: How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity.

Proverbs 17:17: A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for a time of adversity.

Ephesians 4:13: This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God's Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ.

Let us pray:

1. Let's ask God for perfect love, peace with in our families as well as the spirit of forgiveness. Let the spirit of love over flow within our families, let's pray against any spirit of dysfunctionality within families, the spirit of unforgiveness, worry, stress, divorce.
2. Pray for peace of Christ to rule in our hearts, so that we can be known as loving church, let love dominate in our lives and church.
3. Pray for our church to be united in faith, and in full knowledge of the Son of God.
